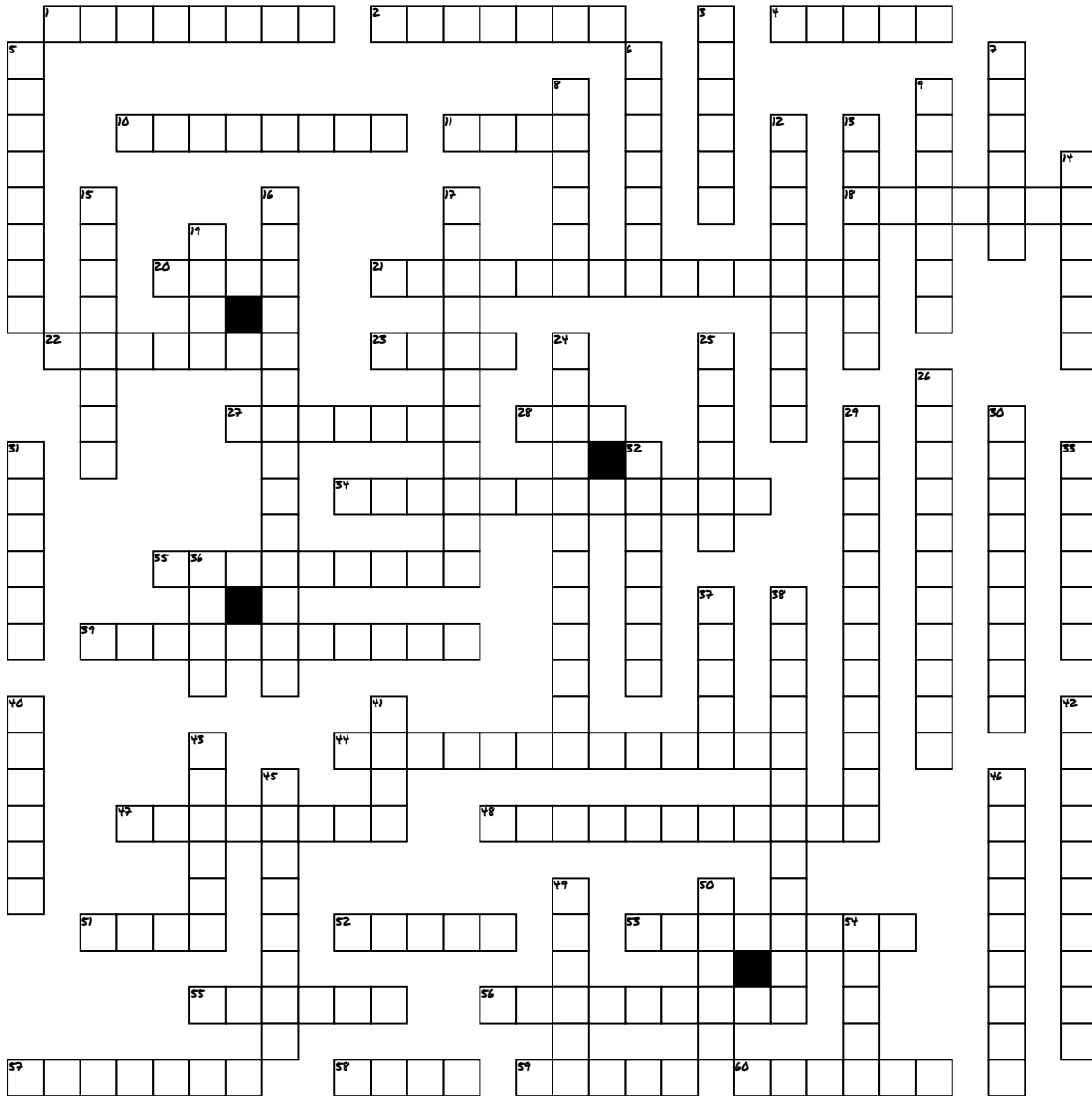

BOOKS OF THE BIBLE



- ACROSS**
- PLEADS WITH GOD TO STOP THE INJUSTICE AND VIOLENCE IN JUDAH, BUT IS SURPRISED TO FIND THAT GOD WILL USE THE EVIL MOSE VIOLENT BARBERSHOP TO DO SO.
 - WARMS THE NEIGHBORING NATION OF EDOM THAT THEY WILL BE JUDGED FOR PLUNDERING JERUSALEM.
 - HOW TO LEAD ORDERLY, COUNTER-CULTURAL CHURCHES ON THE ISLAND OF CAPE.
 - PAUL IS HEARING THE END OF HIS LIFE, AND ENCOURAGES HIM TO CONTINUE PREACHING THE WORD.
 - THIS BRIEF ACCOUNT OF JESUS' EARLY MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS JESUS' AUTHORITY AND SERVANTHOOD.
 - WHAT'S THE FOURTH BOOK OF THE OT?
 - THE BOOK WHERE TWO WOMEN OF MOAB, HAD MARRIED TWO SONS OF ELIMELECH AND NAOMI, JUDGMENT WHO HAS SETTLED IN MOAB TO ESCAPE A Famine IN JUDAH.
 - ENCOURAGES THEM TO "DECEL STILL MORE" IN FAITH, HOPE, AND LOVE.
 - A LETTER ENCOURAGING CHRISTIANS TO CLING TO CHRIST DESPITE PERSECUTION, BECAUSE HE IS GREATER.
 - A SHEPHERD NAMED AMOS PREACHES AGAINST THE INJUSTICE OF THE NORTHERN KINGDOM OF ISRAEL.
 - GOD HAS BEEN PATIENT TO ISRAEL, BUT THEY CONTINUE TO LIVE DISCONNECTED FROM HIM.
 - SATHAN ATTACKS A RIGHTEOUS MAN NAMED JOB, AND JOB AND HIS FRIENDS ARGUE ABOUT WHY TERRIBLE THINGS ARE HAPPENING TO HIM.
 - A PHILOSOPHICAL EXPLORATION OF THE MEANING OF LIFE—WITH A SURPRISINGLY nihilistic TONE FOR THE BIBLE.
 - WHAT'S THE THIRD BOOK OF THE BIBLE OF THE OT?
 - DAVID'S SON SOLOMON BUILDS THE TEMPLE, BUT AFTER CENTURIES OF REJECTING GOD, THE BABYLONIANS TAKE THE SOUTHERN ISRAELITES CAPTIVE AND DESTROY THE TEMPLE.
 - A LOVE SONG (OR COLLECTION OF LOVE SONGS) CELEBRATING LOVE, DESIRE, AND MARRIAGE.
 - RECOMMENDS TO ACCEPT HIS RUNAWAY SLAVE AS A BROTHER, NOT A SLAVE.
 - AN ENCOURAGING LETTER TO THE CHURCH, TELLING THEM HOW TO HAVE JOY IN CHRIST.
 - JESUS RETURNS TO THE FATHER, THE HOLY SPIRIT COMES TO THE CHURCH, AND THE GOSPEL OF JESUS SPREADS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD.
 - A PROPHETIC PROPHECY RUNS FROM GOD, IS SWALLOWED BY A GREAT FISH, AND THEN PREACHES GOD'S MESSAGE TO THE CITY OF NINEVEH.
 - INSTRUCTION ON HOW TO LEAD A CHURCH WITH SOUND TEACHING AND A GOSPEL EXAMPLE.

- GOD SENDS THE PROPHET ISAIAH TO WARN ISRAEL OF FUTURE JUDGMENT—BUT ALSO TO TELL THEM ABOUT A COMING KING AND SERVANT WHO WILL "BEAR THE SINS OF MANY."
- PAUL WRITES TO THE CHURCH AT CORINTH ABOUT HOW TO WALK IN GRACE, PEACE, AND LOVE.
- THIS IS AN ACCOUNT OF JESUS' LIFE, DEATH, AND RESURRECTION, FOCUSING ON JESUS' ROLE AS THE TRUE KING OF THE JEWS.
- GOD SENDS A PLAGUE OF LOCUSTS TO JUDGE ISRAEL, BUT HIS JUDGMENT ON THE SURROUNDING NATIONS IS COMING, TOO.
- LETTER TELLING CHRISTIANS TO LIVE IN WAYS THAT DEMONSTRATE THEIR FAITH IN ACTION.
- PAUL SUMMARIZES HOW THE GOSPEL OF JESUS WORKS IN A LETTER TO THE CHURCHES AT ROME, WHERE HE PLANS TO VISIT.
- SCHERAR HATCHES A GOSPEL PLOT TO BRING ABOUT ISRAEL'S EXTINCTION, AND ESTHER MUST FACE THE EMPEROR TO ASK FOR HELP.
- THE CITY OF JERUSALEM IS IN BAD SHAPE, SO NEHEMIAH REBUILDS THE WALL AROUND THE CITY.
- GOD CHOOSES A MAN TO SPEAK FOR HIM TO ISRAEL, TO TELL THEM THE WORDS OF THEIR WANTS AND TEACH THEM JUSTICE. EZEKIEL.
- BECOMES A HIGH-RANKING WISE MAN IN THE BABYLONIAN AND PERSIAN EMPIRES, AND HAS PROPHETIC VISIONS CONCERNING ISRAEL'S FUTURE.
- WHERE BOTH KINGDOMS IGNORE GOD AND HIS PROPHECY, UNTIL THEY BOTH FALL CAPTIVE TO OTHER WORLD EMPIRES.
- TALKS ABOUT THE CHRONOLOGICAL NARRATIVE OF SAUL AND DAVID.
- GOD WARNS THAT HE WILL JUDGE ISRAEL AND THE SURROUNDING NATIONS, BUT ALSO THAT HE WILL RESTORE THEM IN PEACE AND JUSTICE.
- THE VERY FIRST BOOK OF THE BIBLE OT.
- A COLLECTION OF 150 SONGS THAT ISRAEL SANG TO GOD (AND TO EACH OTHER)—KIND OF LIKE A HYMNAL FOR THE ANCIENT ISRAELITES.
- A COLLECTION OF SAYINGS WRITTEN TO HELP PEOPLE MAKE WISE DECISIONS THAT BRING ABOUT JUSTICE.
- PAUL INSTRUCTS THEM HOW TO STAND FIRM UNTIL THE COMING OF JESUS.
- THIS IS A BRIEF HISTORY OF ISRAEL FROM ADAM TO DAVID, CULMINATING WITH DAVID COMMISSIONING THE TEMPLE OF GOD IN JERUSALEM.
- WRITES THE MOST THOUGHSH ACCOUNT OF JESUS' LIFE, PULLING TOGETHER EIGHTY-THREE TESTIMONIES TO TELL THE FULL STORY OF JESUS.

- ANSWERS SOME QUESTIONS THAT THEY'VE HAD ABOUT HOW CHRISTIANS SHOULD BEHAVE.
- DESCRIBES THE SETTLEMENT OF THE LAND, SAMUEL THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE LAND AND PEOPLE UNDER DAVID, AND KING'S DESTRUCTION OF KINGSHIP.
- WHAT IS THE FIFTH BOOK OF THE OT?
- PAUL WRITES A LETTER OF RECONCILIATION TO THE CHURCH AT CORINTH, AND CLEARS UP SOME CONCERN THAT THEY HAVE.
- CHURCHES HAVE BEEN LEAD TO THINK THAT SALVATION COMES FROM THE LAW OF MOSES, AND WRITES A (LEATHER HEATED) LETTER TELLING THEM WHERE THE FALSE TEACHERS HAVE IT WRONG.
- WRITES TO CHRISTIANS WHO ARE BEING PERSECUTED, ENCOURAGING THEM TO TESTIFY TO THE TRUTH AND LIVE ACCORDINGLY.
- THE BOOK WHERE SAUL IS KING.
- THE PEOPLE HAVE ABANDONED THE WORK OF RESTORING GOD'S TEMPLE IN JERUSALEM.
- THE ISRAELITES REBUILT THE TEMPLE IN JERUSALEM, AND A SCRIBE NAMED EZRA TEACHES THE PEOPLE TO ONCE AGAIN OBEY GOD'S LAWS.
- FORETELLS OF GOD'S JUDGMENT ON NINEVEH, THE CAPITAL OF ASSYRIA.
- A COLLECTION OF DIRGES LAMENTING THE FALL OF JERUSALEM AFTER THE BABYLONIAN ATTACKS.
- TELLING ABOUT THE LAW OF MOSES AND THE DEPARTURE OF THE ISRAELITES FROM EGYPT.
- LISTS STORIES OF SIGNS AND MIRACLES WITH THE HOPE THAT READERS WILL BELIEVE IN JESUS.
- LETTER ABOUT WHO THEY ARE IN CHRIST, AND HOW TO WALK IN CHRIST.
- WHERE THE KINGDOM OF ISRAEL HAS A TIME OF PEACE AND PROSPERITY UNDER KING SOLOMON, BUT AFTERWARD SPLITS, AND THE TWO LINES OF KINGS TURN AWAY FROM GOD.
- GOD SENDS A PROPHET TO WARN ISRAEL ABOUT THE COMING BABYLONIAN CAPTIVITY, BUT THE PEOPLE DON'T TAKE THE NEWS VERY WELL.
- CALLS ISRAEL TO RETURN TO GOD, AND RECORDS PROPHETIC VISIONS THAT SHOW WHAT'S HAPPENING BEHIND THE SCENES.
- WHERE THE ISRAELITES WERE LEAD ACROSS THE JORDAN RIVER AND TAKE POSSESSION OF THE PROMISED LAND.
- CONFRONTS THE LEADERS OF ISRAEL AND JUDAH REGARDING THEIR INJUSTICE, AND PROPHECIES THAT ONE DAY THE LORD HIMSELF WILL RULE IN PERFECT JUSTICE.
- TOLD TO MARRY A PROSTITUTE WHO LEAVES HIM, AND HE MUST BRING HER BACK: A PICTURE OF GOD'S RELATIONSHIP WITH ISRAEL.
