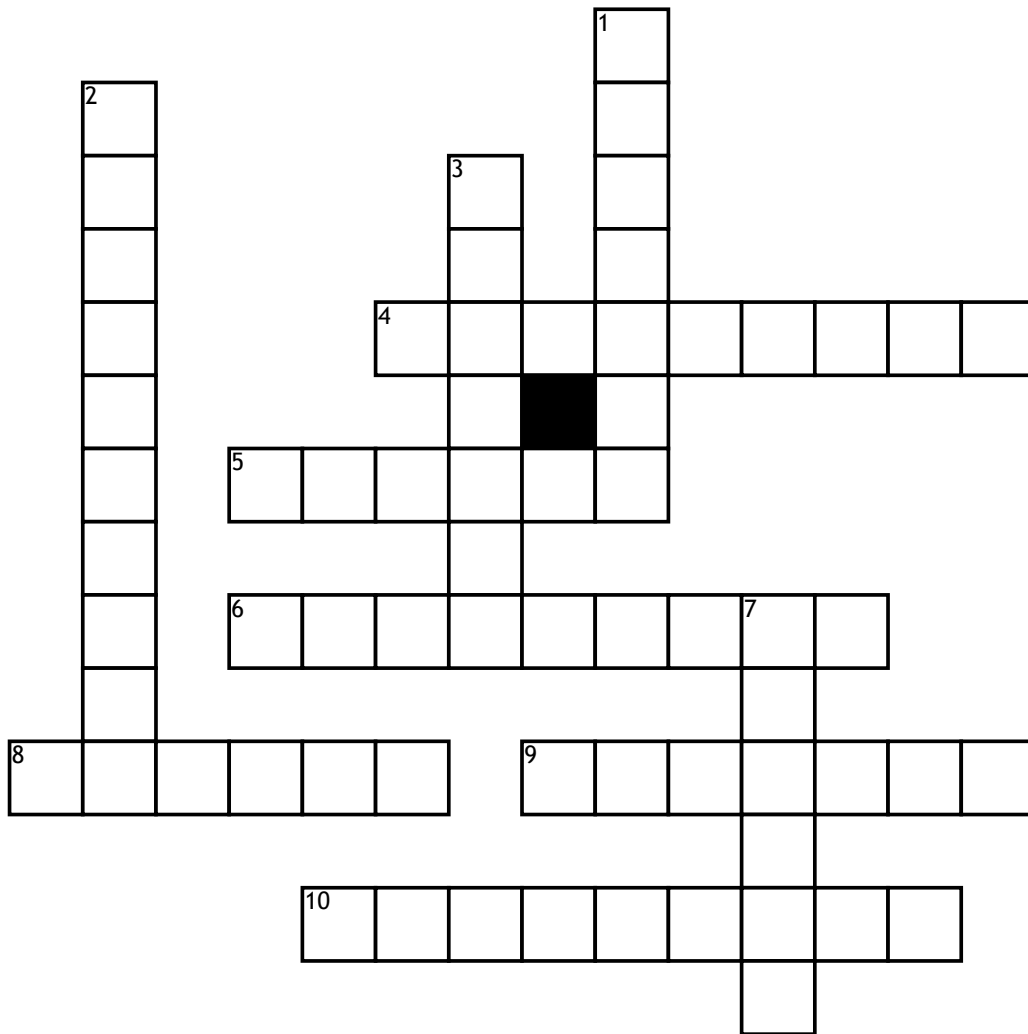


cede, ceed, cess = go; yield
