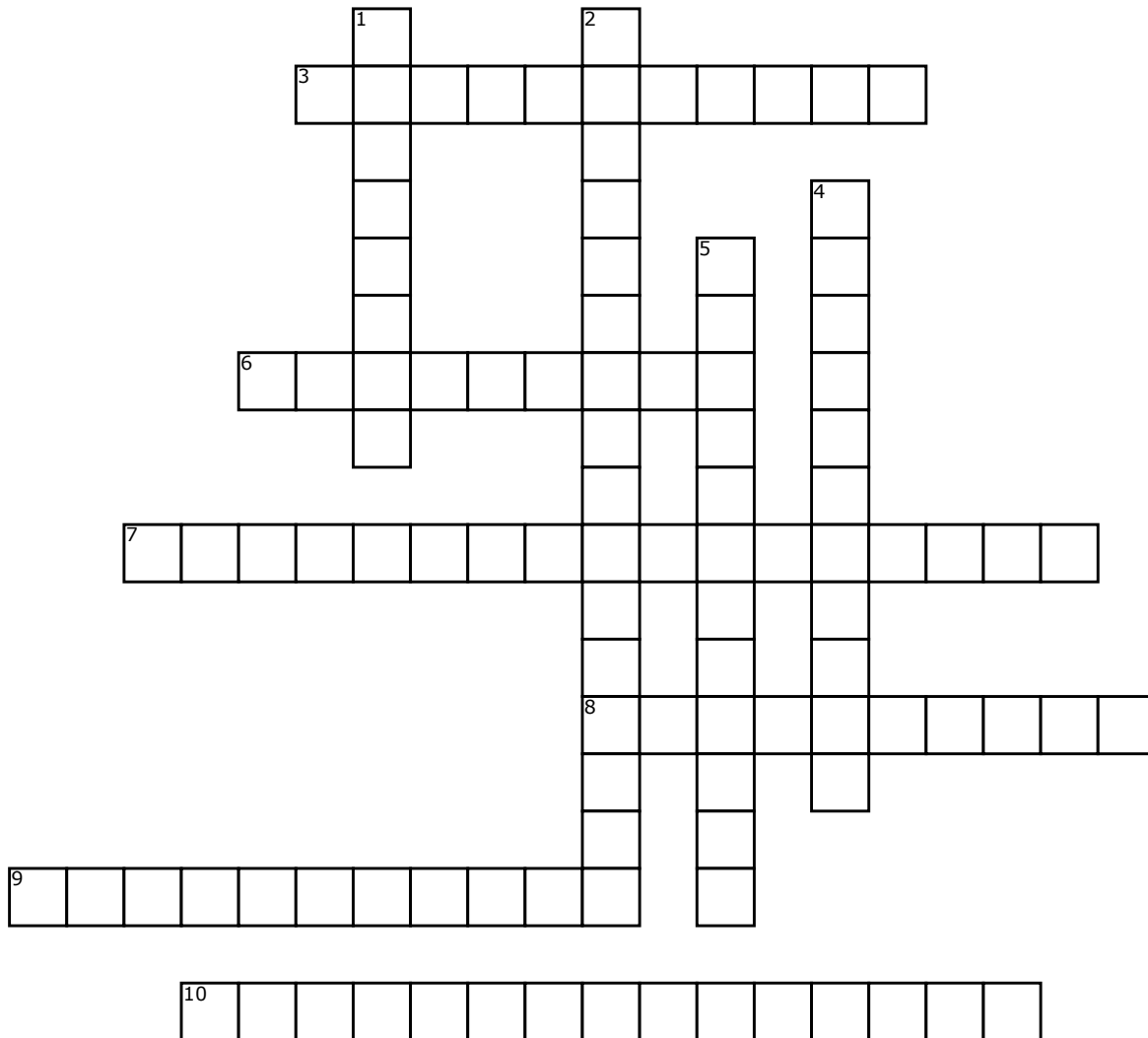

- 3.** perm wrap in which one endpaper is folded over the hair like an envelope
- 6.** absorbent papers used to control the ends of the hair when wrapping and winding hair on perm rods.
- 7.** long chains of amino acids joined together by peptide bonds.
- 8.** Compounds made up of carbon, oxygen, hydrogen, nitrogen, and sulfur.
- 9.** Perm rods that have a smaller diameter in the center that increases to a larger diameter on the ends.
- 10.** long coiled polypeptide chains.

- 1.** Also known as circle rod; tool that is usually about 12-inches long with a uniform diameter along the entire length of the rod.
- 2.** Perm activated by an outside heat source, usually a conventional hood-type hair dryer.
- 4.** perm rods that are equal in diameter along their entire length.
- 5.** Subsections of panels into which hair is divided for perm wrapping; one rod is normally placed on each base section.
