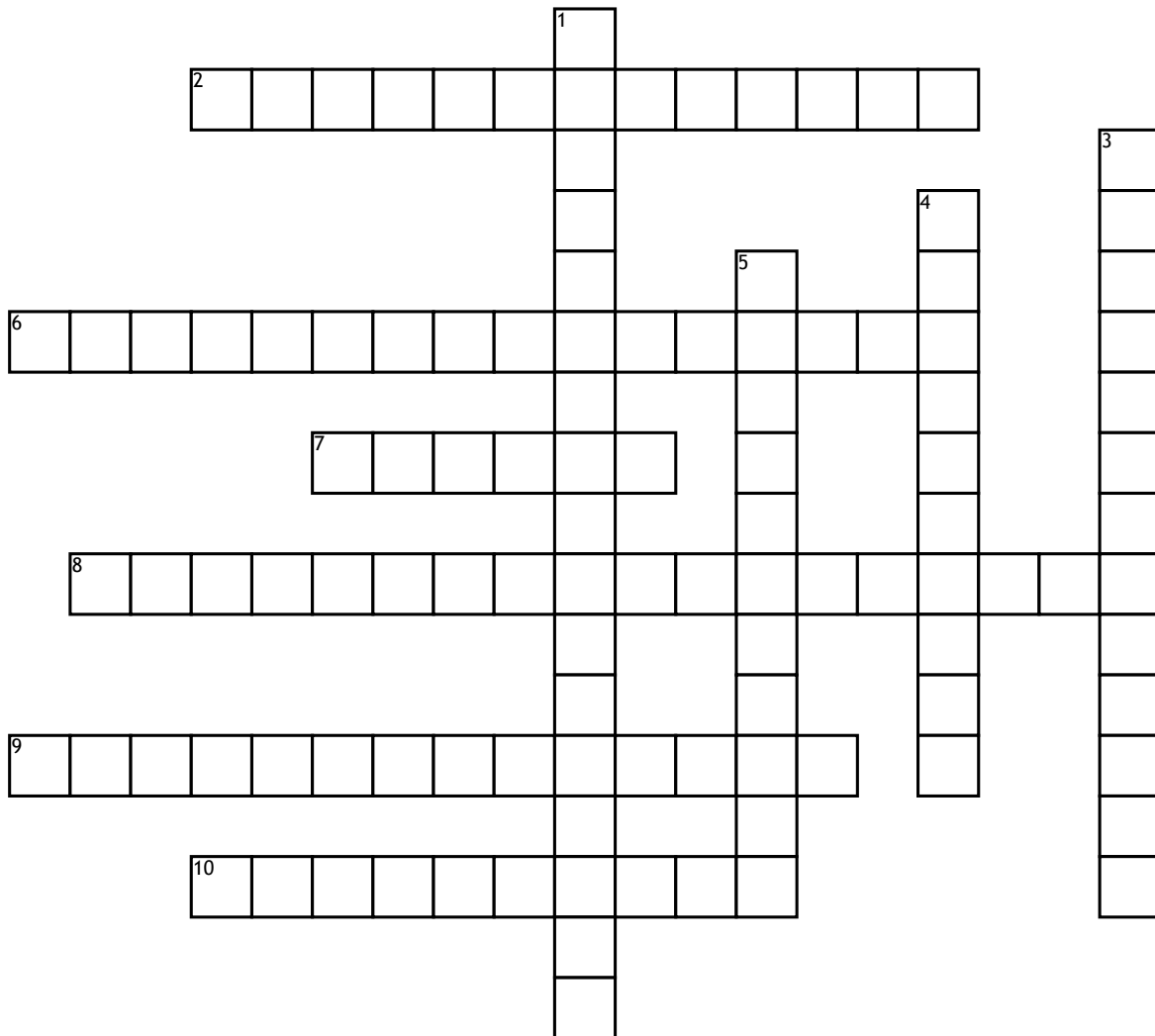


fossils and evolution

1. a process of fossilization in which mineral deposits form internal casts of organisms. Carried by water, these minerals fill the spaces within organic tissue
3. natural breaking down of dead organisms by fungi bacteria insects and worms
4. hollow area shape of the organism
5. provide evidence of activities of the organism
