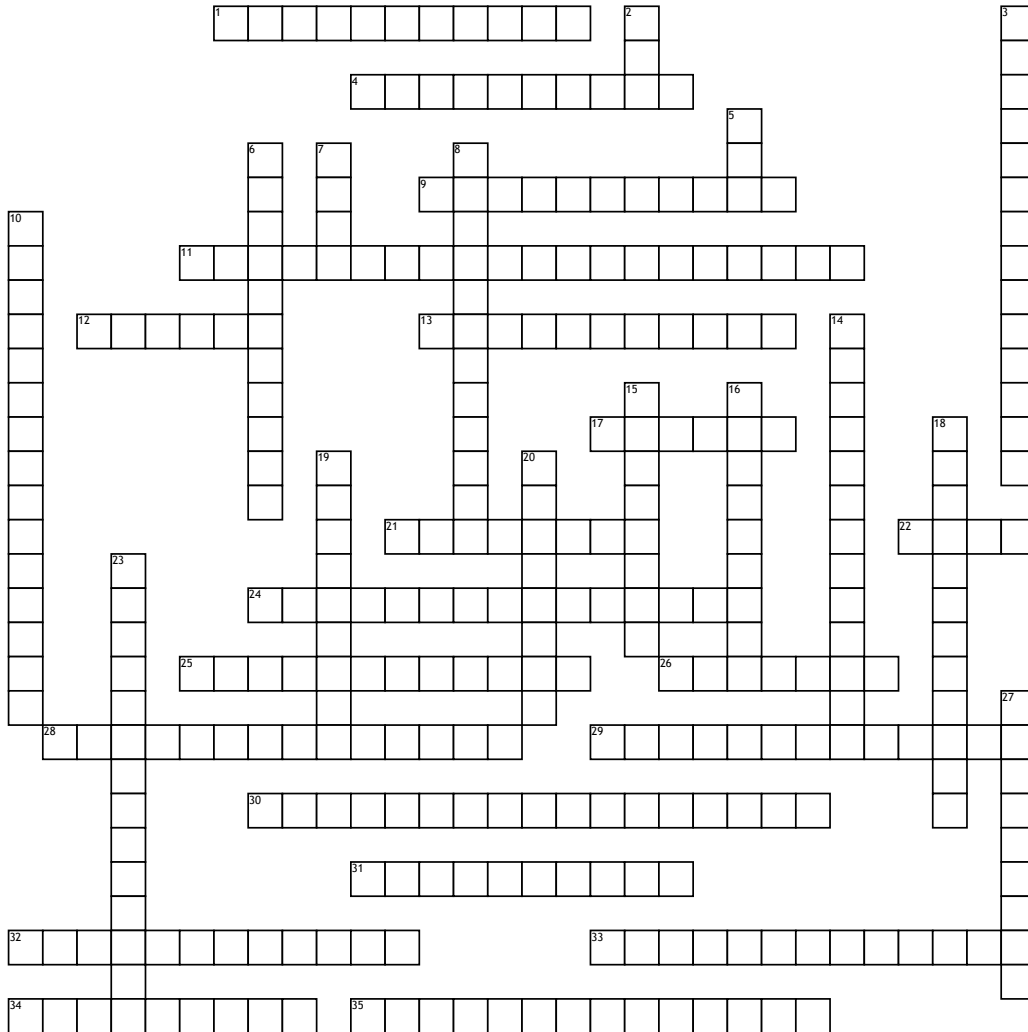


# history us crossword puzzle 1920s-1930s
