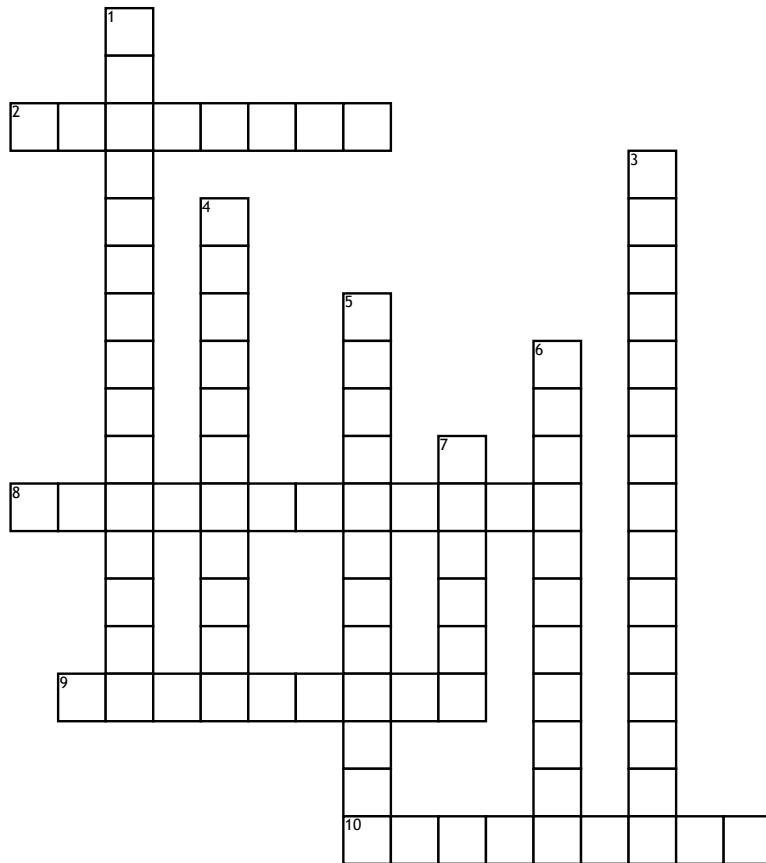

2. A comparison made without using 'like' or 'as'.
8. The repetition of the same sounds usually at the beginning of words.
9. Over-the-top exaggeration for effect.
10. The repetition of vowel sounds in a series of words.



## Down

1. The environment (usually the weather) reflects the mood of the character or scene.
3. A type of imagery in which non-human objects, animals or ideas are given human characteristics.
4. Repetition in a group of three to strengthen an idea or argument.
5. The sounds of words to express or underline their meaning, sensory imagery.
6. Implied meanings suggested by a word rather than its literal meanings.
7. A comparison using 'like' or 'as' to create a vivid image.
