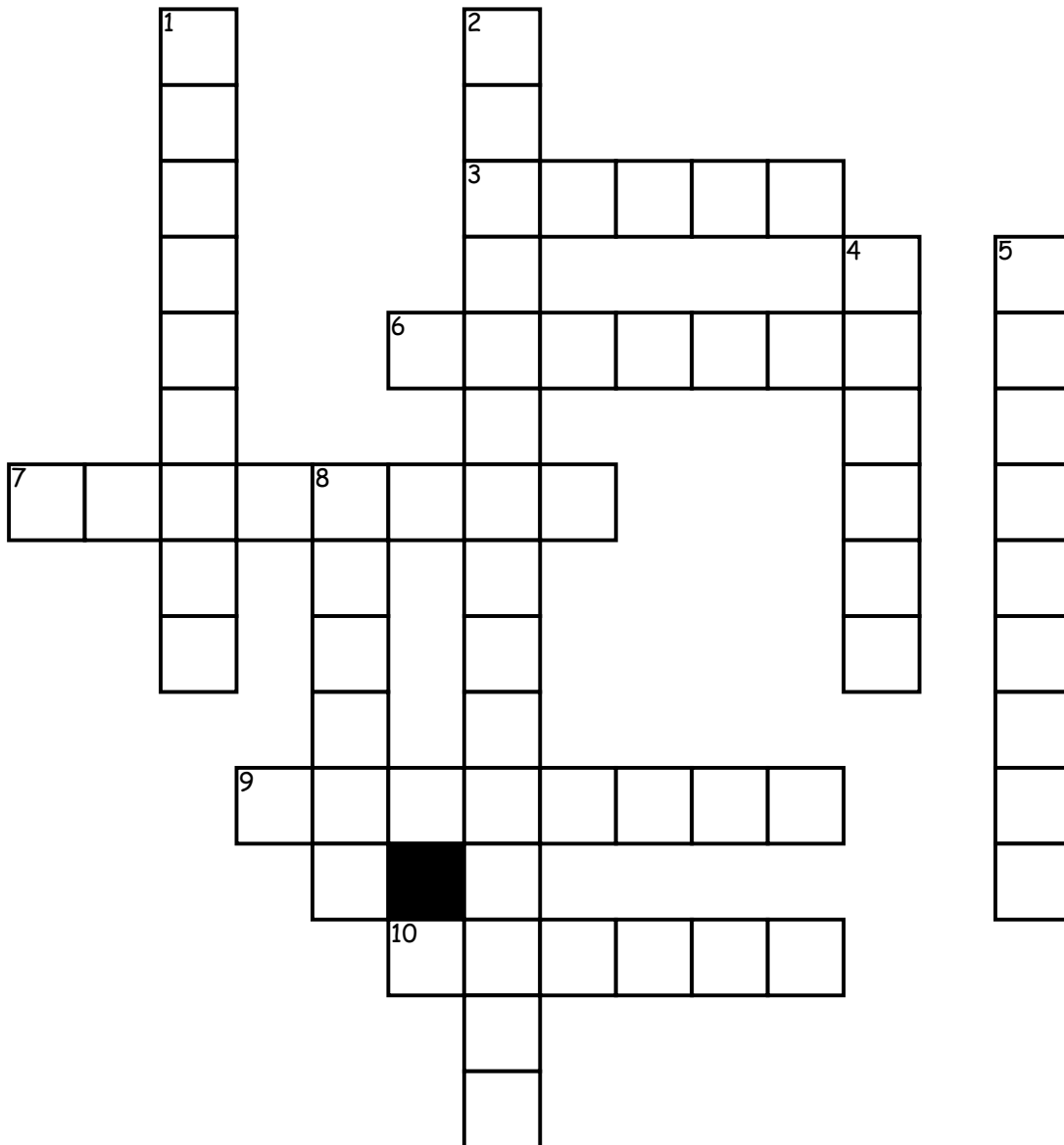

6. A two line stanza
7. A poem in which the beginning, middle or last letters of each line form a word when read vertically
9. An image where one thing is said to be something else. Like the simile, it is based on a point of similarity, but this image identifies them completely
10. A comparison of one thing with another, where the words 'like' or 'as' are used

1. Poetry written with lines of irregular verse and often without rhyme
2. The effect created when a non-human object or quality is written about as if it were a human being
4. Stanza A group of lines of verse, arranged in a particular way
5. A figure of speech which uses exaggeration to emphasise a point
8. A fourteen line poem, written in iambic pentameter. Traditionally about the theme of love
