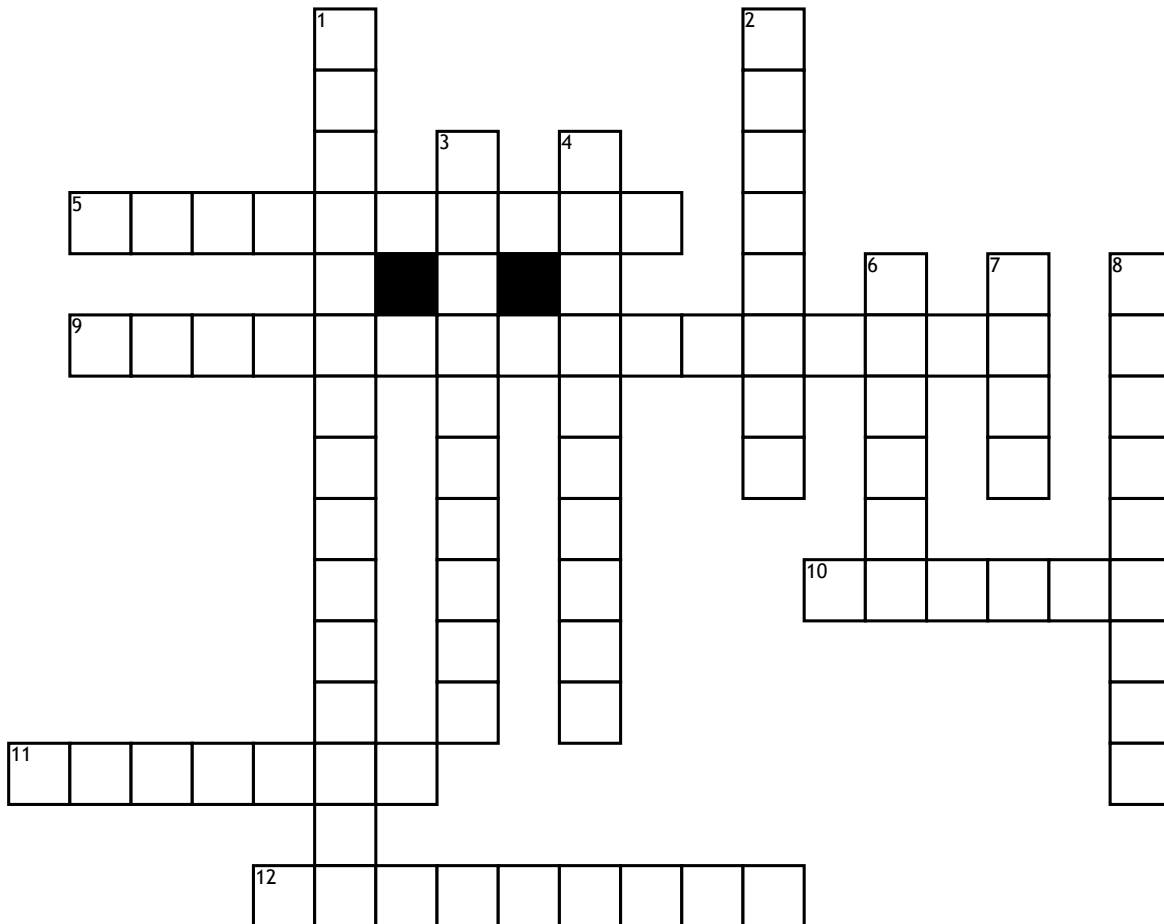

5. complete and entire collection of elements to be studied
9. data consisting of numbers representing counts or measurements
10. collection of data from every element in a population
11. level of measurement of data; characterizes data that consist of names, labels, or categories only.
12. measured characteristic of a population

Down

1. data that can be separated into different categories distinguishing by some non numeric characteristics
2. data result when the number of a possible values is either a finite number or a 'countable' number of possible values.
3. Collection of methods for planning experiments, obtaining data, organizing, summarizing, presenting, analyzing, interpreting, and drawing conclusions based on data
4. data result from infinitely many possible values that correspond to some continuous scale that covers a range of values without gaps, interruptions, or jumps.
6. subset of a population
7. Numbers or information describing some characteristics
8. measured characteristic of a sample
