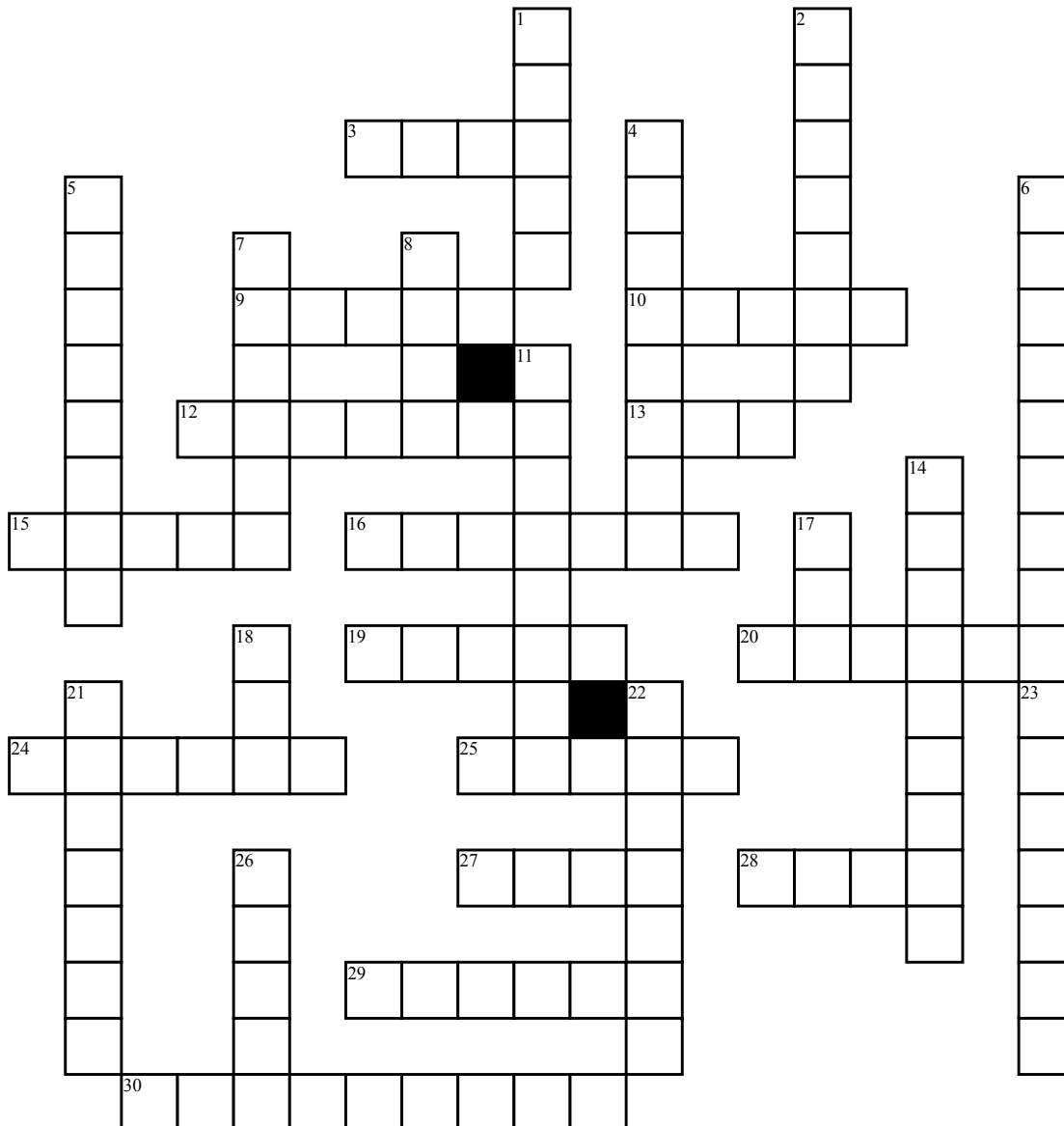

3. food made of flour, water, and yeast or another leavening agent, mixed together and baked
9. a long curved fruit which grows in clusters and has soft pulpy flesh and yellow skin when ripe
10. a yellow, oval citrus fruit with thick skin and fragrant, acidic juice
12. a cylindrical length of minced and seasoned pork, beef, or other meat encased in a skin, typically sold raw to be grilled, boiled, or fried before eating
13. a liquid dish, typically made by boiling meat, fish, or vegetables, etc. in stock or water
15. A pale yellow edible fatty substance made by churning cream and used as a spread or in cooking
16. cream which has been deliberately fermented by the addition of certain bacteria
19. a sweet yellowish or brownish green edible fruit that is typically narrow at the stalk and wider toward the base, with sweet, slightly gritty flesh
20. a fungal growth typically takes the form of a domed cap on a stalk, with gills on the underside of the cape

24. an opaque white fluid dish in fat and protein, secreted by female mammals for the nourishment of their young
25. a sweet crystalline substance obtained from various plants, consisting essentially of sucrose, and used as a sweetener
27. an open pastry case containing filling
28. a hot drink made from the roasted and ground seeds of a tropical shrub
29. a herbaceous plant widely cultivated as a source of food for humans and live stock, and for processing into sugar
30. an item of food consisting of two pieces of bread with meat, cheese, or other filling between them, eaten as a light meal

1. the large fruit of a plant of the gourd family, with smooth green skin, red pulp, and watery juice
2. a glossy red, or occasionally yellow, pulpy edible fruit that is eaten as a vegetable or in salad
4. a round juicy citrus fruit with a tough bright reddish-yellow rind

5. a berry, typically green, purple, red, or black, eaten as a fruit or used in making wine
6. a dish originally from Italy consisting of dough made from durum wheat and water, extruded or stamped into various shapes and typically cooked in boiling water
7. the round fruit of a tree of the rose family, which typically has thin red or green skin and crisp flesh
8. a dish consisting of oatmeal or another meal or cereal boiled in water or milk
11. a starchy plant tuber which is one of the most important food crops, cooked and eaten as a vegetable
14. a round patty of ground beef, fried or grilled and typically served on a bun or roll and garnished with various condiments
17. a food made from the pressed curds of milk
18. an edible bulb with a pungent taste and smell, composed of several concentric layers, used in cooking
21. a tapering orange colored root eaten as a vegetable
22. a meal eaten in the morning, the first of the day
23. a small sweet cake, typically round, flat, and crisp
26. a cold dish of various mixtures of raw or cooked vegetables
