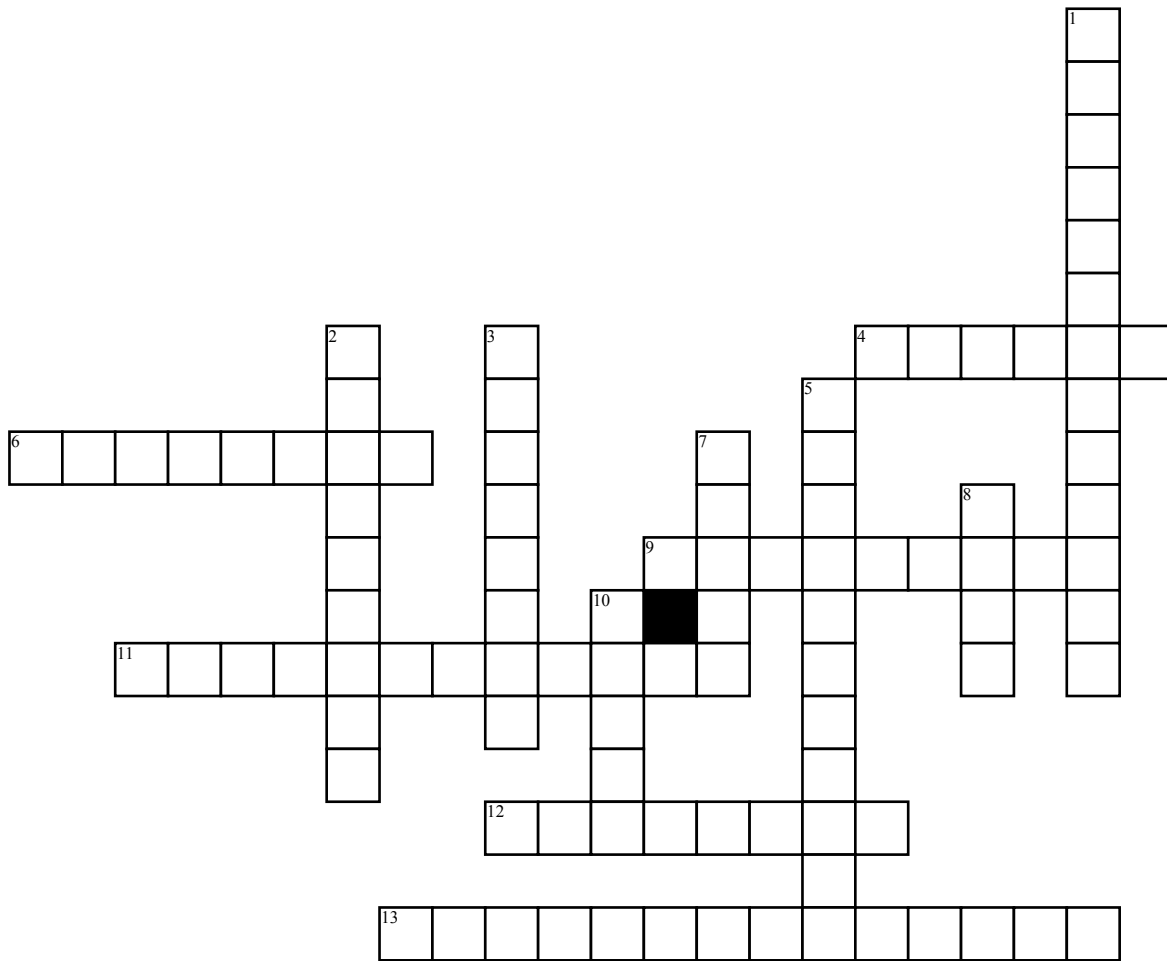

4. Goods are goods to be manufactured or produced or acquired by the seller after the making of the contract of sale

6. Good are goods which are already owned or possessed by the seller

1. Goods are goods which are identified by description only

2. As astipulation essential to the main purpose of the contract that may give the right to repudiate the contract

3. Is a stipulation collateral to the main purpose of the contract that may give the right to claim for damages but not the right to reject or repudiate the contract

5. A contract of sale may be made in writing or by word if mouth or may be implied from the conduct of the parties
