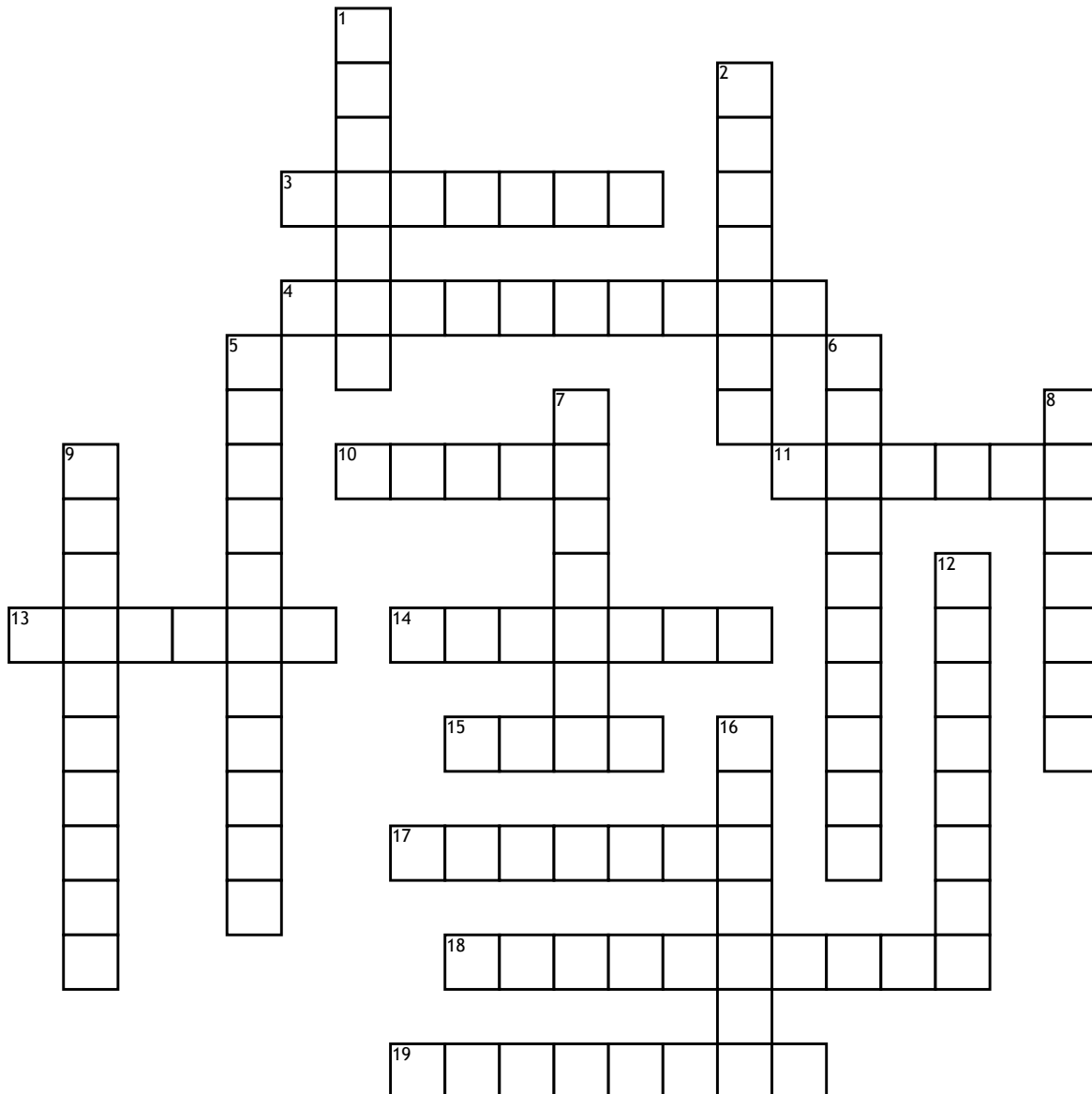

1. is a defensive position in football, so called because their job is to 'sweep up' any attacking moves which pass other defenders
