surgical devices

1. all equipment used in the practice of medicine
 2. instrument inserted into joint cavity to inspect contents
 3. hollow instrument used to withdraw fluid, from body cavities cysts(joints)
 4. a device used to sterilize instruments with pressurized, superheated steam
 5. narrow-bladed surgical knife used to open abscesses & make small incisions
 6. tube inserted into narrow opening for removal or introduction of fluids
 7. surgical instrument used to compress blood vessel/ close of end of intestine
 8. flexible band used to compress/ close off opening
 9. spoon-shaped instrument used to scrape tissue from body cavities
 10. instrument used to view interior of bladder
 11. electrode-tipped blade used to coagulate tissue/ small blood vessels
 12. tube/ wick used to draw fluid from body cavity to surface
 13. tube used to drain fluid from inside of body
 14. slender, tubular instrument used for viewing & examining interior body parts
 15. instrument used to file/ rasp a horse's premolar & molar teeth
 16. fluorescent screen on which x-rays may be viewed
 17. many instruments used to grasp & pull objects
 18. device used to stop or prevent hemorrhaging
 19. needle & syringe used for injection under the skin
 20. anesthesia administered by inhaling
 21. device that administers medicinal vapors
 22. instrument that measures & records pulse-pressure variations
 23. wide, two-edged, pointed surgical knife
