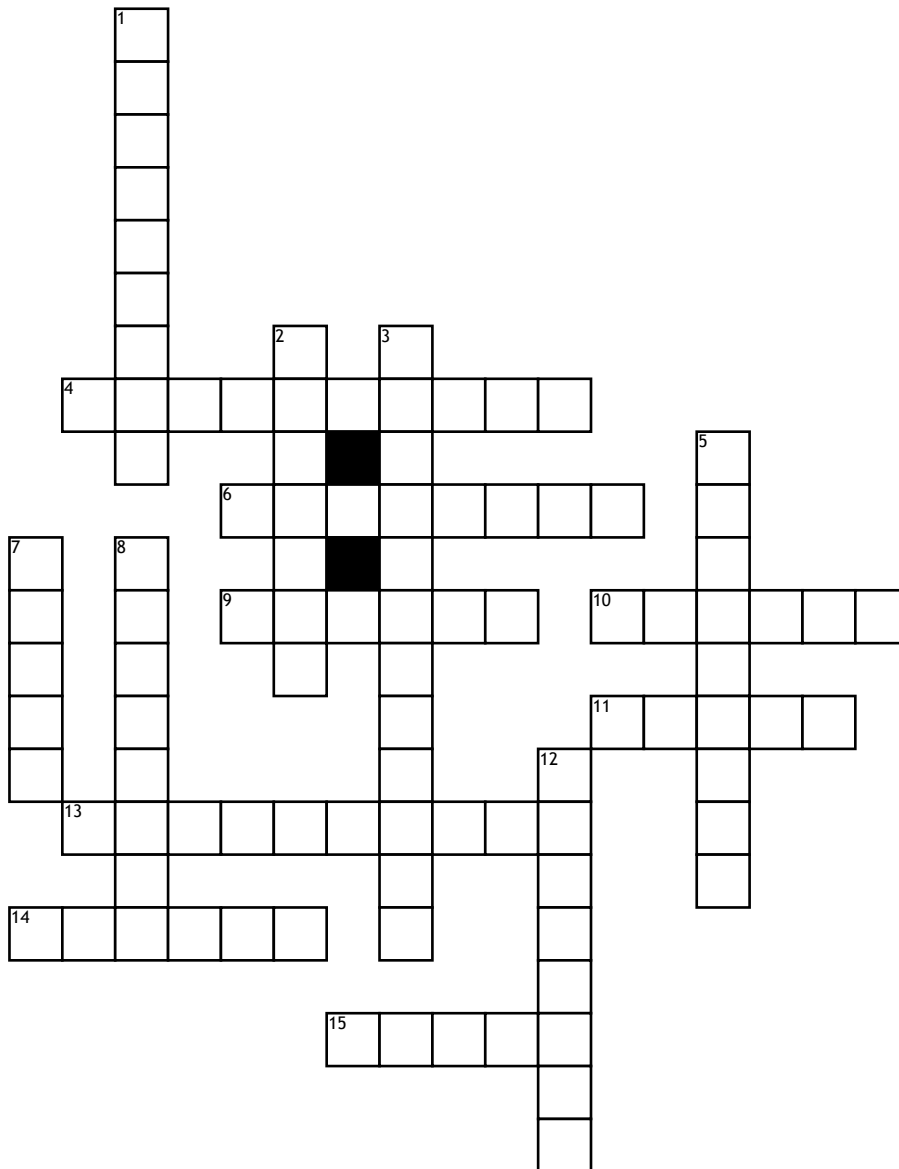


# tunnels of blood
