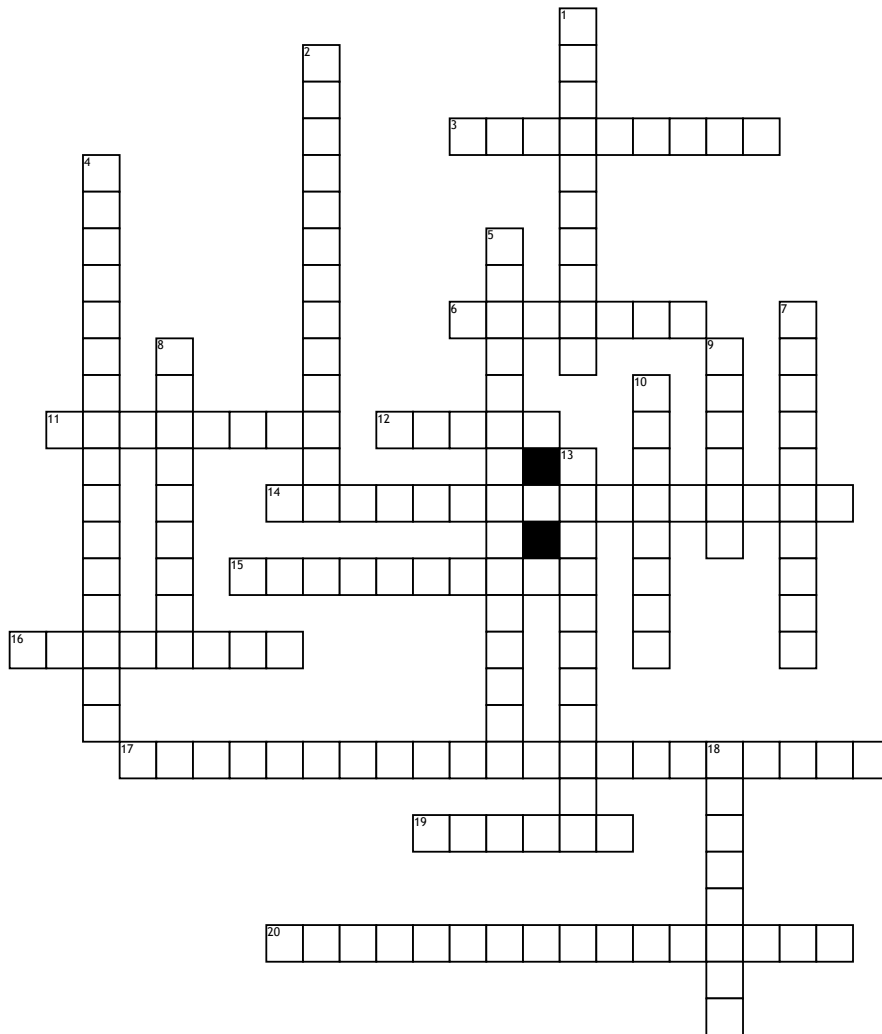


# veterinary terminology
