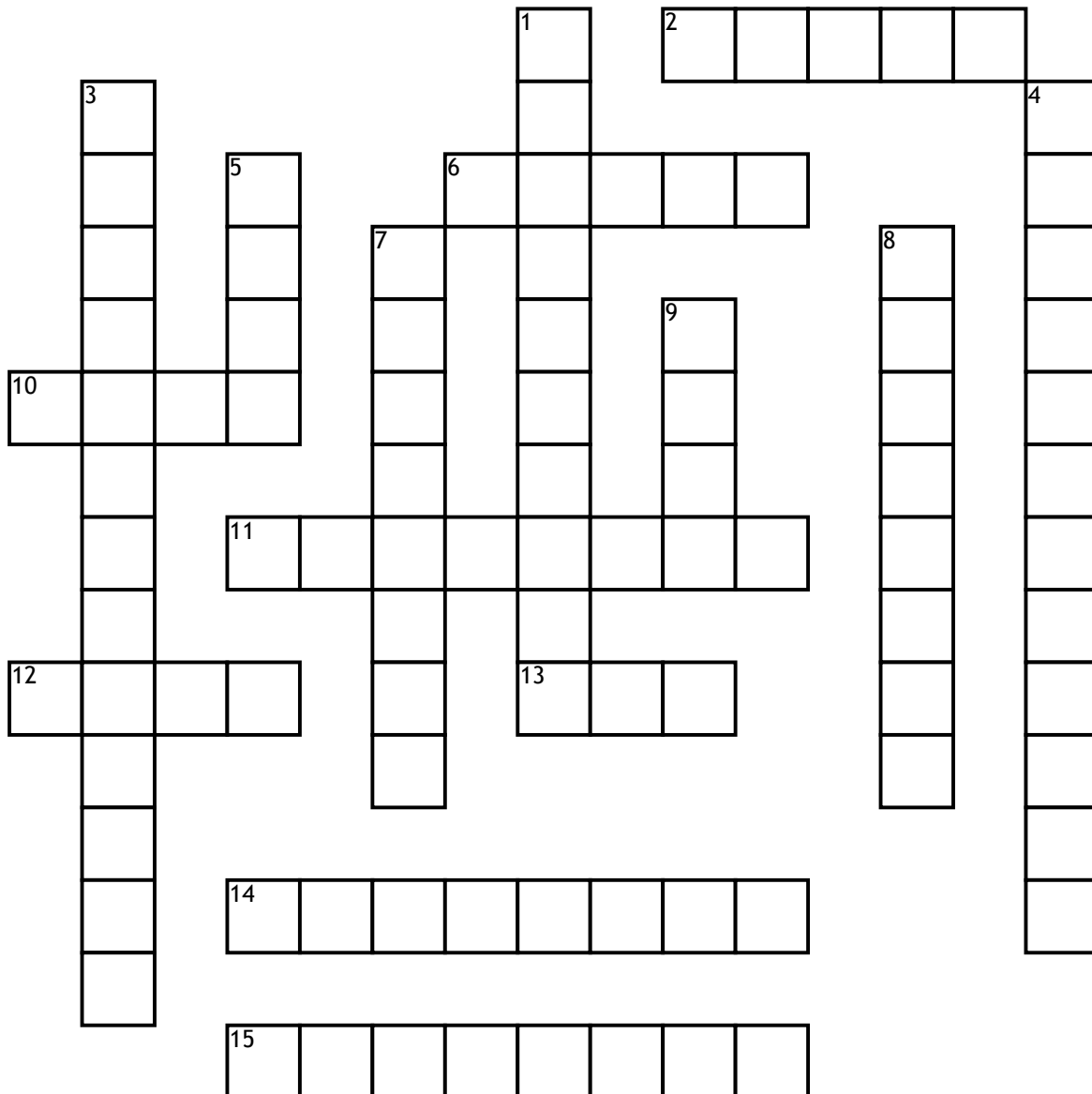

2. Sky condition of less than 1/10 cloud coverage

6. Until two hours after sunrise

10. horizontal movement of air relative to the earth's surface and is caused by variations in temperature and pressure

11. The temperature to which the air must be cooled for water vapor to condense and form fog or clouds

12. Describes weather in which there is less than 4/10ths of opaque cloud cover, no precipitation, and there is no extreme visibility, wind or temperature conditions

13. Sunrise to sunset.

14. A fog in which the visibility is less than one-quarter mile.

15. Cloud or rain droplets containing pollutants, such as oxides of sulfur and nitrogen, to make them acidic

1. A flood that occurs within a few hours

3. Liquid or solid water that falls from the atmosphere and reaches the ground

4. A cloud in the shape of individual detached domes, with a flat base and a bulging upper portion resembling cauliflower.

5. In the winter, cold refers to four to seven degrees Celsius below normal

7. A strong, cold, downslope wind.

8. The amount of water vapor in the atmosphere.
